As requested, I write to inform you that none of the eggs supplied by Michael Foods are affected by the recent Wright County Egg recall.

Michael Foods sources eggs from its own farms and various suppliers, including Wright County Egg. All of the eggs we receive from Wright County Egg are pasteurized, using a process that goes beyond the USDA minimums to ensure the destruction of Salmonella; therefore, none of the eggs that we purchase from Wright County are affected by its recent recall.
